OFFICE MEMO

Govt. of the People's Republic of Bangladesh have been pleased to order that Officers of Govt./Semi Govt./Autonomous/Semi-Autonomous and other Organisations be encouraged to take the Scout-Masters' and Cub Masters' Courses of training when such camps are held in their Areas, provided such permission being given in each case by their respective Controlling Officers.

Govt. have also decided that Officers who are members of the Bangladesh Boy Scouts Society, may be allowed to attend the Council Meeting, Executive Council Meeting, National Scout Jamborees, Scout Rallies, Conference Training Courses and other Scout Gatherings. Prior permission of the controlling authority, as the case may be, should however, be obtained in each case.

In all such cases the period of the absence from their offices be treated as on duty. But in such cases the absence should not exceed 30 days.

The officers concerned shall also be entitled to draw T.A. etc. for the purpose in terms of Appendix No. 15(f) of the Bengal Service Rule Part-II, copy of which is enclosed herewith for ready reference.

This has the concurrence of the Ministry of Finance, Govt. of the People's Republic of Bangladesh.

It is requested that this may be communicated to all officers concerned.
